I: *MS annotations in Geste's hand:* *author index*

It is not possible to determine exactly when Geste made these annotations and, as all but a very few items were imported from the continent, it is likely that in most instances the annotations date at the earliest from a year or more *after* the imprint dates. Where evidence survives indicating Geste's acquisition of an item later than the imprint date (e.g. in the case of an item acquired at a later date from a former owner or carrying a dated presentation), the item is entered at the date of acquisition ('>' to indicate 'later than') and the imprint date shown in brackets (e.g. 1551 > [1546]). As it is clear that Geste acquired and annotated some items unbound or in temporary covers before more permanent binding (often with other items of later date) it has been thought best to list all other items under the imprint date rather than suggest a later date for his annotations, e.g. after the latest imprint in the case of multi-itemed volumes.
